



## Update on I-64/I-264 Construction Activities

March 2, 2017

As part of VDOT's ongoing effort to keep stakeholders updated on project impacts, please note that demolition of the sound barrier wall along I-64 west is scheduled to begin in the coming days, potentially as soon as Friday, March 3. Residents and others along Newtown Road can expect to see traffic from construction vehicles increase because of this operation, as well as from the start of additional land-clearing operations closer to the I-64/I-264 interchange.

The demolition is expected to take approximately three weeks, with work hours running from 7 a.m. to 5 p.m. weekdays. A new sound wall will be installed as the project nears completion. Removal of the original wall is necessary to build a new I-64 off-ramp.
